SENIOR SOFTWARE DEVELOPER
INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SPECIALIST – III**

JOB DESCRIPTION: The California State Senate seeks a motivated and accomplished Senior Software Developer with strong programming and communication skills to design, develop code, test, deploy mission critical Senate applications for payroll, financial, and workflow applications. Job responsibilities include: 1) analyze business requirements; 2) architect software and database solutions; 3) build prototype web applications; 4) design and code custom software applications.

Located in downtown Sacramento, the Senate Office of Information Technology is a small, agile, dynamic workplace that encourages developers to work directly with internal customers and build creative solutions. Senior developers have a wide range of discretion and are expected to work independently to plan and accomplish goals. While the Senate primarily uses Microsoft .NET (and Python for miscellaneous tasks), talented full stack web developers, who may not have .NET experience, are encouraged to apply, provided they have the required skills and a strong interest in learning the Microsoft platform (.NET, C#, MS-SQL).

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidates must have strong analytical, design, programming, and problem solving skills, plus at least 4 years' experience as a full stack web developer, programming on a modern web platform such as .NET, Java, Python, PHP, GO, etc. Additionally, candidates must have professional experience with SQL and at least one relational database management system, as well as a thorough understanding of data structures: including dictionaries, lists, hash tables, tuples. Experience using command line tools (i.e. PowerShell or BASH), source control repositories (GIT, TFS), and at least one JavaScript framework (jQuery, angular, react, or ember, etc.) are also vital to success. Finally, this position works directly with internal and external customers, so excellent communication, teamwork, and customer service skills are paramount.

DESIRED SKILLS:

Expert and demonstrated skills in the following areas are highly desirable: knowledge of algorithms, object-oriented programming, software engineering principles; and application security best practices. A bachelor's degree in Computer Science or related field is strongly preferred. Experience with cloud services such as AWS, Azure, Google Cloud is desirable.

Salary range for this position starts at \$6392 per month. The California Senate offers a generous benefits package to employees. Applications will be accepted until the position is filled.
