**Proclamation by Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger
2009–10
SECOND EXTRAORDINARY SESSION
(Convened December 2, 2008)**

WHEREAS, an extraordinary occasion has arisen and now exists requiring that the Legislature of the State of California be convened in extraordinary session.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ARNOLD SCHWARZENEGGER, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by Article IV, Section 3(b) of the Constitution of the State of California, do hereby convene the Legislature of the State of California to meet in extraordinary session at Sacramento, California on the 1st day of December 2008, at a time to be determined, for the following purpose and to legislate upon the following subjects:

1. To consider and act upon legislation to address the economy, including but not limited to efforts to stimulate California's economy and create and retain jobs.
2. To consider and act upon legislation to address the housing mortgage crisis.
3. To consider and act upon legislation to address the solvency of the Unemployment Insurance Fund.
4. To consider and act upon legislation to address inefficiencies in state and local governments and to streamline state and local government operations.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed this 1st day of December, 2008.
